Paul made sure when he wrote the church at Colossae that Epaphras was commended. Apparently, Epaphras prayed with such force and intensity for that church that Paul referred to it as wrestling. And Paul commended him for it.

We will give you an opportunity later in the service to stand and encourage us by highlighting how you have seen God working in and through someone else.
