Shake This Place

What does "wide awake" look like? Remember Nehemiah in the Old Testament? He was cupbearer to the king of Persia, and in a fact-finding conversation regarding the state of things in Jerusalem, he found out that they were in a very bad way. Here's what being wide away looked like for him....

When I heard these things, I sat down and wept. For some days I mourned and fasted and prayed before the God of heaven. Then I said:

"O LORD, God of heaven, the great and awesome God, who keeps his covenant of love with those who love him and obey his commands, let your ear be attentive and your eyes open to hear the prayer your servant is praying before you day and night for your servants, the people of Israel.

I confess the sins we Israelites, including myself and my father's house, have committed against you. We have acted very wickedly toward you. We have not obeyed the commands, decrees and laws you gave your servant Moses.

Remember the instruction you gave your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations, but if you return to me and obey my commands, then even if your exiled people are at the farthest horizon, I will gather them from there and bring them to the place I have chosen as a dwelling for my Name. They are your servants and your people, whom you redeemed by your great strength and your mighty hand. O Lord, let your ear be attentive to the prayer of this your servant and to the prayer of your servants who delight in revering your name. Give your servant success today by granting him favor in the presence of this man. Nehemiah 1:4-11

PRAYER

Lord, this man didn't need to go there. He had a cushy life. And yet his heart was ready to empathize with the needs of his people in a far off place. He took on your concerns. You raised him up for that time. He was willing to put his reputation - even perhaps his very life on the line, in order to be obedient to you. The church at Ephesus had fallen asleep. And Jesus grabbed them by their shoulders to rouse them. How so? Listen to His words in Revelation 2:2-5...

I know your deeds, your hard work and your perseverance. I know that you cannot tolerate wicked men, that you have tested those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them false. You have persevered and have endured hardships for my name, and have not grown weary. Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken your first love. Remember the height from which you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place.

Well, for a moment let's reflect through this song on the hour we first believed, and the grace of God that will act like smelling salts to awaken us from our slumber.

Amazing Grace

(after verse 3, have several share of some "dangers, toils and snares" that God has brought them through recently)

Be careful, or your hearts will be weighed down with dissipation, drunkenness and the anxieties of life, and that day will close on you unexpectedly like a trap. For it will come upon all those who live on the face of the whole earth. Be always on the watch, and pray that you may be able to escape all that is about to happen, and that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man." Luke 21:34
